**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** Vernon A. Stephens, Irene D. Stephens and Dr. A. H. Ross  
551 Country Club Road, Eugene  
of 537 Country Club Road, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Debrick Slough a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16814 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Northwest Corner of Lot 12 ( $NE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{3}{4}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.9 acres in Lot 12 ( $NE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$ )  
4.1 acres in Lot 11 ( $SE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 30  
T. 17 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning in the SE corner of the Jacob Gillespie Donation Land Claim No. 70, in Township 17 South of Range 3 West of Willamette Meridian, and running thence north  $0^{\circ} 15'$  east along the east line of the claim, 500 ft., thence north  $70^{\circ} 04'$  east, 80.6 feet, thence north  $87^{\circ}$  east 144.8 ft., thence north  $0^{\circ} 15'$  east 83.5 feet, thence east 225.7 feet, thence south  $1^{\circ} 17'$  west 236.3 feet to the south bank of a slough, thence west 221.3 feet to a point north  $0^{\circ} 15'$  east 464.64 feet from a point in the center line of County Road No. 515, south  $70^{\circ} 08'$  East 226.3 feet from the SE corner of the Donation Land Claim No. 70, thence south  $0^{\circ} 15'$  west 464.64 feet to the center line of County Road No. 515, thence north  $70^{\circ} 08'$  west along the center line of the County Road, 233.6 feet to the place of beginning, containing 4.60 acres more or less in Lane County, Oregon. Beginning on the East line of the Jacob Gillespie D.L.C. No. 70 in Township 17 South, Range 3 West W.M., at a point 500 feet North  $0^{\circ} 15'$  East from the Southeast corner of said claim, and running thence N.  $0^{\circ} 15'$  E 450.4 ft. to the Northwest corner of Lot 12 in Section 30, of said Township and Range, thence S.  $89^{\circ} 45'$  E 144.8 ft. along the North line of said lot 12, thence S.  $29^{\circ} 50'$  E 211.0 ft. thence S.  $0^{\circ} 15'$  W 231.9 ft. thence S.  $87^{\circ}$  W 144.8 ft. thence S.  $70^{\circ} 04'$  W 80.6 ft. to the place of beginning, containing more or less 1.905 acres

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
