CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Mrs. Hazel Campbell

of Star Route Box 31, Korbel, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed gulch a tributary of Jump Off Joe Creek, tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of mining and domestic for one family, including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre under Permit No. 17132 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 5, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.01 cubic feet per second, being 2.00 c.f.s. for mining and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W. M. and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, Township 34 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Deed recorded in Vol. 218 and page 192 of Jackson County deed records as follows: Robert G. Campbell and Hazel F. Campbell, husband and wife, transfreeing one half interest to George Kobelback and Ila P. Kobelback, husband and wife, the following property situated in the county of Jackson state of Oregon, described as follows: The fractional west half of the northwest quarter of section 31 township 34 south and range 4 west of the Willamette Meridian Oregon. Containing 73 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
