CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That . Wm. S. Dickinson

of Route 1, Gold Hill , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Sardine Creek

a tributary of Rogue River

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 17429 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 5, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE_4^1 NE_4^1 , Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, V_0 V_0

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{12}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres in SE¹ NE¹ Section 8.
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section Eight (8) Township Thirty-Six (36) South, Range three (3) West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; running thence North 592 feet to the South line of the R/W of E. C. Fiene roadway; thence east 352 feet along said right-of-way; thence Southwesterly 512 feet, thence West 256 feet to the point of beginning.

The above tract being all of that portion of the Nina Dusenberry tract lying South of the E. C. Fiene private roadway.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
