## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That David Tonelli Grants Pass

offit. 2 Box 565, Riverbanks Road/, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dutcher Creek

a tributary of Rogue River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17505 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance of the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 11, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_4^1$   $SW_4^1$  and  $SW_4^1$   $SW_{4}^1$ , as projected on John Dutcher D. L. C. 38, Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

30.0 acres in SW2 SW2, as projected on John Dutcher D. L. C. 38
18.0 acres in SE2 SW2, as projected on John Dutcher D. L. C. 38
12.0 acres in WW2 SW2, as projected on John Dutcher D. L. C. 38
Section 11
T. 36 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Also commencing at the northeast corner of said Donation Land Claim No. 38 and running thence East 330 feet; thence South 1320 feet; thence West 330 feet; thence North 1320 feet to the place of beginning, and being the West half of Lot 10, all of the above described premises being in Section 14, in Township 36 South Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian, and containing 69.29 acres.

Also beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 14 in Township 36 South Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence East 1122 feet; thence North 1631 feet; thence North 70° West 576.7 feet; thence South 29° 35' West 630 feet; thence South 11° 52' West 1308.5 feet to the place of beginning, containing 36.57 acres. Lot 7 in Section 14, also commencing at the southeast corner of the John Dutcher Donation Land Claim No. 38, and running thence North to the Northeast corner of said Donation Land Claim; thence West 13 chains; thence South to the South line of said Donation Land Claim; thence East to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
