CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Woodrow W. Donoho

of Vida _____, State of Oregon _____, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring _____ a tributary of McKenzie River _____ for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation under Permit No. 16088 _____ of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 28, 1911.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.003 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW₄ SE₄, Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.25 acre and domestic in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 34
T. 16 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: One and one half acres (1½) out of the Northeast corner of the following described land — The West side of Lot (3) Section Thirty four (34) Township sixteen (16) Range Two East (2E) W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
