of P. O. Box 937, Boise , State of Idaho , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Crooked River

a tributary of Deschutes River

for the purpose of

development of 715.9 theoretical horsepower

under Permit No. 17809 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters nas been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 17, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 175 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 SW4, Section 11, Township 12 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to __ _ _ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
