**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** L. E. Shimm

of Route 2 Box 385, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation and domestic use for one family under Permit No. 18000 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 6, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.024 cubic foot per second, being 0.014 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Joseph McKinney D. L. C. 45, Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 1.1 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on Joseph McKinney D. L. C. 45 Section 23  
T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe, set in the county road, from which the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner between sections 23 & 24, twp. 26 S; R. 6 W; Wm. bears South 1428.3 ft. and East 1317.5 ft. Thence S.55\*10'W. 223. ft. to a point on the edge of the North Umpqua River, Thence following the said river, downstream, N.43\*30'W. 200.1 ft. to a point. Thence N. 55\*10' E. 287. ft. to a point in the center of the said road Thence following the center of said road, S.17\* E. 211.1 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 1.1 acres more or less and all being located in section 23; twp. 26 S; R.6W; Wm. Douglas co. Ore.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
