CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Harry L. Riches

of 302 McClaine Street, Silverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18224 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 13, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.004 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Thomas L. Coon D. L. C., Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Thomas Coon D. L. C.
Section 34
T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the northeasterly line of McClaine Street with the Northwesterly line of Craig Street in the city of Silverton, Marion County, Oregon, which point is the most southerly corner of the tract of land, thence north 44 degrees west along the northeasterly line of McClaine Street 66 feet; thence north 46 degrees east parallel with the northwesterly line of said Silver Creek; thence southeasterly along the west bank of Silver Creek to the northwesterly line of Craig Street; thence South 52 degrees 40 feet west along the northwesterly line of Craig Street 4.85 chains more or less, to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
