and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at puge 322; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount netually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.19 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 10 acres in Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; 5 acres in Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
