that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0,013 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the IN ST1, Section 15, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $rac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in NW2 SW2 Section 15 .T. 34 S., R. 1 V., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

All that portion of Lot 3, Section 15, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon, lying between County Road known as Gold Hill Road, and Rogue River and West of that certain tract of land theretofore conveyed to Earnest W. and Eva Segesman, husband and wife, as described in Volume 185, Page 67, Deed Records, of Jackson County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
