## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Maud E. Bigelow

of P. O. Box 12, Kerby , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Illinois River

a tributary of Rogue River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 18934 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from August 15, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second

or  $u_{\alpha}$  equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SE_{\alpha}^{1}$  NW $_{\alpha}^{1}$ , Section 27, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $3\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall

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conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

0.3 acre in SW4 SE4 Section 4 T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Property on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described

by appropriator as follows:

appurtenant, is as follows:

Beginning at a point 16 chains and 600 feet south of the Northeast corner of the James Kerby Donation Land Claim Number 37, in Township 39South, Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon and run thence East 118 feet, thence southerly 150 feet along the west line of the Redwood Highway thence west to the East line of aforesaid Donation Land Claim, thence north along the East line of aforesaid Donation Land Claim to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
