CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DECATUR BALDWIN

Hood River State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Stream a tributary of for the purpose of Columbia River

Irrigation under Permit No. 12633 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 7, 1937;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 NE4, Section 35, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 1.8 acres in Lot 4 Adams Paradise Acreage (now known as Mountain View Addition to Hood River, Oregon) being within the NV4 NE4, Section 35 Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate is to correct and supersode that certain water right certificate WITNESS the signature of the State Engineer, affixed issued by the State Engineer on July 1, 1941, to Decatur Baldwin, which certificate is recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Vol. 12, page 13721, so as to correctly describe the place of use.
