CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. E. PARCEL

of Route 1, Box 158, Rogue River . State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pleasant Creek

atributary of Evans Creek, a tributary of Rogue River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17497 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from February 6, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.063 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE1 NW1, Section 15, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed h_2^2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5 acres in the NE NV, Section 15, T. 35 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the quarter corner common to Sections 10 and 15, Twp. 35 South, Range & West, W.M. in Jackson County, Oregon; thence S. 0°02' W., 855.2 feet to a point in Evans Creek from which a 36" cotton wood tree scribed B. T. bears N. 30°15' W. 93.2 feet; thence S. ½2°36' W. 520.0 feet along Evans Creek to the intersection of Pleasant Creek, from which a white Oak 8" in diameter scribed B. T. bears S. 53°15' W. 1½9.0 feet; thence N. 20°6' W., 1311.3 feet along the center line of Fleasant Creek to a point which is situated South 89032 feet west 803.4 feet from the point of beginning: thence N. 89°32' E. 803.4 feet to the point of beginning, excepting therefrom a 30 foot strip along the north boundary for county road purposes, containing 14.3 acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
