CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARK S. & PAULINE R. YOUNG

of Route 1, Cave Junction , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Page Creek

a tributary of East Fork Illinois River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17670 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 8, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NN SWA, Section 2, Township 41 South, Range 8
West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3 acres in SWA NEA 18 acres in SEA NEA Section 3, T. 41 S., R. 8 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at the east bank of the East Fork Illinois River, at a point which is 1728 feet Mest of the East quarter corner of Section 3, in Township 41 South, Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Oregon; thence running East 1728 feet to said Section corner; thence running North 542 feet to the South line of the Page Creek road; thence North 76° 15' West 1790 feet to the East line of a county road; thence South 80° West 255 feet, more or less to the East bank of the East Fork Illinois River; thence Southerly along said east bank of the point of beginning, containing 33 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
