CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLYDE RAYMOND SMITH

of Route 1, Box 62, Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring a tributary of Applegate Watershed, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic for two families, including the irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre, and stock under Permit No. 19010 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 23, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for stock,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Jackson County Deed Records, Volume 183, Page 126, and Volume 215, Page 349, describe applicant's lands as follows: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and lands lying north of Applegate River in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 38 South, Range 3 West, W. M., all in Jackson County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
