CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That F. M. LOCKWOOD

of Walla Walla State of Washington has a right to the use of the waters of Middle Branch of Mud Creek, a tributary of East Branch of Mud Creek,

for the purpose of supplementing water supply from East Branch of Mud Creek, for leaching alkali and winter irrigation from September first to April first only,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3 at page 322 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1893;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.50 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Seventeen (17), 10 acres in Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Sixteen (16), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
