for the purpose of the irrigation of twenty acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Participation of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 322; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1893 for the irrigation of ten acres and from 1902 for ten acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.25 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 10 acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 10 acres in Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Six (6) North, Mange Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.
