CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That E. J. DAVIS

of Freewater State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Springs,

for the purpose of the irrigation of two acres and sub-irrigation of 38 acres, domestic and stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 323 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1906 for the irrigation of 2 acres and from 1908 for 38 acres whenever it becomes necessary to divert water for the irrigation of such land on account of lack of sub-irrigation;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.03 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The rights herein confirmed for the irrigation of thirty-eight acres by sub-irrigation, shall not be taken to confirm the right to divert water on said lands except in the event that such lands should in the future cease to sub-irrigate and then only provided that such diversion shall not interfere with the rights of the present appropriators below as determined in said decree, in which case 0.48 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, under priority date of 1908, may be diverted for the irrigation of said 38 acres.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
