CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That JULIUS HAASCH

of Freewater State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of West Prong of Little Walla Walla River and Spring Branch,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 25 acres of land, the development of 1/3 horse-power, domestic and stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 323 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1901 for power and the irrigation of 11 acres; from 1885 for 7 acres, all from West Prong of Little Walla Walla, and from 1895 for 7 acres from Spring Branch;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 cubic foot per second for power and 0.32 cubic foot per second for irrigation, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 16 acres in Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 2 acres in Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter; 7 acres in Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter, Section Twenty-two (22), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

Wheel located in Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon. Water returned to stream at place of use.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
