that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose saforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose s, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.24 cubic foot per second or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 9.5 acres in Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fifteen (15), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
