Freewater State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of West Prong of Little Walla Walla River,

for the purpose of the irrigation of ten acres and the development of one horse power; also domestic and stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at in the Order Record of the Im-; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1890;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pura rate of flow of 3.00 cubic feet per second for pose s, and shall not exceed power and 0.25 sec. ft. for irrigation or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtinant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

10 acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fifteen (15), Township Six (6) North Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, in Umatilla County, Oregon.

Power developed in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Fifteen, (15), Township Six (6) North Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, subject to irrigation rights; returned to stream at place of use.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use hevein described.
