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285 Couch Street, Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the unnamed stream , a tributary of Columbia River waters of for the purpose of the development of one theoretical horsepower, utilizing a fall of 52 feet and domestic use Permit No. 3265 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume , on the at page 24th day of September, 1917 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 5, 1917 ; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes uforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not cubic for per second. 0.15

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenunt, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), Township One (1) North, Range Five (5) East of Willamette Meridian, in Multnomah County, Oregon.

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The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
