CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That A. E. HIGH, M. G. HOPE & I. W. HOPE of Vale State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Little Willow and Turner Creeks, tributaries of Willow Creek

for the purpose of the irrigation of 320 acres of land, domestic, stock and storage

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3 at page 285 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1903;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.67 sec.ft. from February 15th to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 960 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 40 acres in SE-NE-; 40 acres in SW-NE-; 40 acres in SW-NW-; 40 acres in SE-NW-; 40 acres in NE-SE-; 40 acres in NW-SE-; 40 acres in SW-SE- and 40 acres in SE-SE- of Section 34, Tp. 16 S. R. 43 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon

This certificate is issued to correct certificate recorded in Vol. 2, at page 1578 of State Record of Water Right Certificates, and on page 56 of Certificate Record No. "E", of Malheur County, Oregon, which erroneously referred to Willow Creek a tributary of Malheur River when it should refer to Little Willow and Turner Creeks, tributaries of Willow Creek.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
