CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That GOLD BEACH WATER, LIGHT & POWER CO.

of Gold Beach, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Main Fork of Riley Creek, a tributary of Riley Creek, for the purpose of domestic use

under Permit No. 1466 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 250, on the 15th day of June, 1917; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 20, 1912; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Section Thirty-six (26) Township Thirty-six (36) South, Range Fifteen (15) West of Willamette Meridian, in Curry County, Oregon.

This certificate is issued to correct certificate recorded in Vol. 2 at page 1659 of State Record of Water Right Certificates, and on page 10 of Certificate Record Vol. 1, of Curry County, Oregon which erroneously refers to the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, Tp. 36 S. R. 14 W.W.M., as the place of use, when it should refer to Section 36, Tp. 36 S. R. 15 W. W. M.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
