CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Beaver , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pole Creek , a tributary of , for the purpose of the irrigation of 12 acres of land, Permit No. 1863 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 271 , on the 7th day of December, 1917; that the priority of January 12, 1914 ; that the amount of the right hereby confirmed dates from water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic for per second, or the equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Office A description of the lunds under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is us follows: 4 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 8 acres in the Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29), Township Three (3) South, Range Nine (9) West of Willamette Meridian, in Tillamook County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
