County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 73; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1897 for the irrigation of twenty-eight (28) acres and from 1909 for the irrigation of twenty-eight and one-half (28) acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 0.47 cubic feet per second as of date 1897 and 0.48 cubic feet per second as of date 1909.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Thirty-two (32) acres in SE_2^1 of SW_2^1 ; ten and one-half (10½) acres in SW_2^2 of SE_2^2 ; fourteen (14) acres in SW_2^2 of SE_2^2 ; Sec. 12, Tp. 3 N. P. 22 E., W. M., in Gilliam County, Oregon.
