CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That J. J. ADAMS 918310 of Heppner State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Rhea Creek, a tributary of Willow Creek

for the purpose of the irrigation of 70.5 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Gilliam and Morrow Counties and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 260; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July, 1907

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed 1.18 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 26.5 acres in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4; 2 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4; Section 1; Tp. 3 S. R. 24 E. W. M., 12.5 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4; 6 acres in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4; 5 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4; 9 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and 7.5 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of section 6, Tp. 3 S. R. 25 E. W. M., in Morrow County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
