CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HAROLD BIGHAM & J. E. FARMSWORTH

of Route 3, Box 357, Canby , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Molalla River

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 16734 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 10, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SNA SEA, as projected on Champing Pendleton D.L.C. #58, Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

HAROLD BIGHAM

2.5 acres in SW1 SE1, as projected on Champing Pendleton D.L.C. #58 1.2 acres in SE1 SE1, as projected on Champing Pendleton D.L.C. #58 Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

J. E. FARNSWORTH

6.0 acres in SE¹ SE¹, as projected on Champing Pendleton D.L.C. #58 Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriators as follows:

FARMSWORTH: Part of the Champing Pendleton D.L.C. No. 58, Tp. 3 S. R. 1 E. of the W.M., more particularly described as beginning 26.81 chains South and 27.85 chains West of the Northeast corner of said claim; thence North 1.53 chains; thence West 9.22 chains; thence South 6.50 chains; thence East 9.22 chains; thence North 4.97 chains to the place of beginning, and containing 6.00 acres, more or less.

BIGHAM: A part of the Champing Pendleton D.L.C. #58 in T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W.M., described as: Beginning at a point 26.81 chains south and 27.35 chains west and 1.53 chains north and 9.22 chains west of the Northeast corner of the Champing Pendleton P.L.C., which beginning point is the northwest corner of a tract of land containing 10.78 acres, conveyed to Ole W. Berg by C. C. Clausen and wife; running thence West 12.03 chains to the Molalla River; thence south and up said River 6.72 chains; thence East 12.03 chains to the West line of the said 10.78 acre tract conveyed to said Ole W. Berg; thence North 6.72 chains to the place of beginning,

containing 8.08 acres of land, more or less, except the north 3.00 acres thereof, conveyed to Julia Nelson and Arthur Melson, her husband, by deed recorded Sept. 27th, 1939 in book 262 of deeds at page 19, Situate in Clackamas County, State of Oregon.

The right to the usc of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
