CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE H. & AGNES M. WILSON

, State of Lowell Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Big Fall Creek a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17763 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1.947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.059 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (NE4 SW4), Section 2, Township 19 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.9 acres in Lot 4 (NE SWL)

1.8 acres in NET SWT, as projected on C. H. Penland D.L.C. #55 Section 2, Township 19 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning 40 rods east of the northwest corner of the George H. Penland Donation Land Claim No. 55 in Township 19 South, Range 1 west of Willamette Meridian and running thence east 62 rods to the center of big Fall creek, thence down said creek to a point north of the place of beginning, thence couth to the place of beginning, containing 3.78 acres more or less. Also beginning at the southwest corner of the above described tract and running thence east 10.12 chains to the center of the County No. 672, thence south 1.85 chains thence west 10.12 chains; thence north 1.85 chains to the place of beginning, Containing 1.87 acres more or less, all in Lane County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
