## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That FRED H. KELLEY

of 512 Tenth St., Independence , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Fork Ash Creek a tributary of Ash Creek, a tributary of Villamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17851 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 28, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEL SEL, as projected on John E. Davidson D.L.C. #UL, Section 29, Township 8 South, Range L Mest, M. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in NE: SE1, as projected on John E. Davidson D.L.C. #hh Section 29 Township 8 South, Range h West, W. H.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Commencing 1 chain west of the northwest corner of Block 7 in White's Addition to Independence, Polk County, Oregon, west 1.39 chains, thence south 3.19 chains, thence east 1.39 chains, thence north 3.19 chains and returning to point of beginning, containing 3.88 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
