CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. H. GIBSON & SON

of Route 3, Junction City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Hulbert Lake a tributary of Long Tom River for the purpose of

irrigation, under Permit No. 17049 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 14, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.19 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 15 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.8 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
- 13.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
- 0.9 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
- 5.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

- 33.7 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 11.7 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 9.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
- 40.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Township 15 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The east half of the Southeast quarter of Section 11 and the West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 12 in Township 15 South of Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian, also commencing at the corner of Sections 11, 12, 13, and 14 in said Township and Range; thence East 20.00 chains, thence North 40.00 chains, thence East 12.25 chains, thence South 16.50 chains, thence West 3.25 chains, thence South 45° West 6.50 chains, thence South 2° West 31.00 chains, thence West 23.20 chains, and thence North 13.50 chains to the place of beginning, containing 65 acres; containing in all 225 acres, more or less, in Lane County, State of Oregon.

2-Roth Tract:

All that portion of the following described property lying South and West of the present highway, known as Pacific Highway 99W: Beginning at a point 12.25 chains East of the Northwest Corner of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twelve, Township Fifteen South, Range Five West of the Willamette Meridian, thence South 36.50 chains, thence West 3.25 chains, thence South 45° West 6.50 chains, thence South 2° West 31 chains, thence West 23.20 chains, thence South 6.50 chains, thence East 25 chains, thence North 11.50 chains, thence East 35 chains, thence North 68.50 chains, and thence West 27.75 chains to the place of beginning, in Lane County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
