CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JOE MARSH**

of **Silverton** , State of **Oregon** , has made prory
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Silver Creek
a tributary of **Pudding River** for the purpose of
irrigation
under Permit No. **17971** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **June 3, 1947**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.015 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$** , as projected on **Bluford Smith D.L.C. #55**,
#55, Section 1, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$** acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year,

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and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

1.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Bluford Smith D.L.C. #55
Section 1
Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by
appropriator as follows:

All that part of the following described tract lying South of the Silverton-Silver
Creek Falls Highway: Beginning at a point North 12° East 2.32 chains from the
Southeast corner of a 20 acre tract conveyed to J. L. Stalker by deed dated April
11, 1892, and recorded in Book 50, Page 263, of the Deed Records of Marion County,
Oregon; thence North 12° East 7.78 chains; thence North 69° 30' West 11.535 chains;
thence South 20° 30' West 18.37 chains; thence South 52° East 0.20 chains; thence
South 24° 30' West 3.72 chains; thence South 49° 17' East 4.54 chains; thence
North 24° 48' East 5.15 chains; thence South 55° 40' East 2.025 chains; thence
South 63° East 1.34 chains; thence South 58° 30' East 0.33 chains to most Westerly
corner of a 5 acre tract of land deeded by Sarah Ramsby to Henry Dick and recorded
in Vol. 210, Page 90, Marion County Record of Deeds; thence North 28° 48' East
11.45 chains thence East 2.46 chains to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
