CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That G. H. MARSHALL, E. O. MC GOLDRICK &

of Haines, W. A. DAUGHERTY, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

two unpaired streams a tributary of Muddy Creek, a tributary of Powder River for the purpose

supplemental irrigation of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters under Permit No. 18460 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 27, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, being 0.08 c.f.s. from south stream & 0.92 c.f.s. from north stream,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 18, & NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 17, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.0 c.f.s.; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 13.8 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4
6.3 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 17

W. A. DAUGHERTY

- 9.2 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20

All in Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

G. H. MARSHALL: The E 1/2 of SE 1/4 (except parts sold) of Sec. 7, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W.M.; and W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 8, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W.M.; and 7 1/2 acres in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 (except parts sold) of Sec. 17, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W.M.; and the SE 1/2

of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (except parts sold) and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, T. 7S R. 39 E., W.M.; and 23.02 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Se. 18, T. 7S R. 39 E., W. M., in Baker County, Oregon.

E. O. MC GOLDRICK: The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W.M.; and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W. M.; and 20 acres in the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., W. M.; and the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ (except parts sold) and the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (except Right of Way) of Sec. 18, T. 7 S., R. 39., E. W. M.; In Baker County, Oregon.

W. A. DAUGHERTY: The NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 20; and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21; T 7 S., R. 39 E., W. M., In Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
