## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN K. PROEBSTEL

, State of , has made proof Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Muddy Creek & Big Muddy Creek a tributary of Powder River for the purpose of irrigation (supplemental) under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters 18316 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 10, 1930

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.50 cubic feet per second, being 1.75 c.f.s. from each stream,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWA NEA from Little Muddy Creek, & SWA NEA from Eig Huddy Creek, Section 19, Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season; and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.50 c.f.s. provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:

40.0 acres in NEA NEA 40.0 acres in NW NW 40.0 acres in SEA NEA 40.0 acres in SWA NWA 16.8 acres in NET SET 36.0 acres in NW Section 19 Section 20 All being within Township 7 South, Range 39 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The north half of the southeast quarter and the east half of the northeast quarter of Section 19; the northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter, the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter, and the north half of the southwest quarter of Section 20; all in Twp. 7 South of Range 39, East of the Willamette Meridian; together with all water and water rights, ditches and ditch rights thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining or used in connection therewith.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
