CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. H. STONE

of Route 2, Troutdale, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fairview Creek a tributary of Columbia Slough for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14811 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 24, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on E. R. Scott D.L.C. #38, Section 33, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on E. R. Scott D.L.C. #38
11.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on E. R. Scott D.L.C. #38
Section 33;

2.9 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on E. R. Scott D.L.C. #38
3.5 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on E. R. Scott D.L.C. #38
Section 34;

Township 1 North, Range 3 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The following described tract of real property situated in the Emsley R. Scott and Martha S. Scott, his wife, Donation Land Claim, Not. #7235, Claim #38, in Sections Twenty-seven, Twenty-eight, Thirty-three and Thirty-four, Township One North, Range Three, East of the Willamette Meridian, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest Corner of the A. C. Dunbar and Esther Ann Dunbar Donation Land Claim, Not. #7108, Claim #41, in Section Thirty-four, thence running North along the line between the Emsley R. Scott and wife and A. C. Dunbar and wife Donation Land Claims 32 chains and 39 links, thence running West on a line at right angles 15 chains and 60 links, thence running South on a line parallel with East line of said Scott Donation Land Claim 32 chains and 39 links, thence running East in a direct line to the place of beginning. Multnomah County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
