CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DUCKWALL BROTHERS, INC.

of Hood River, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Paradise Creek, a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of cooling system for fruit processing plant under Permit No. 17120 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 27, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on William Jenkins D.C. #38, Section 26, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Industrial use in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Nathaniel Coe D.C. #37;
Industrial use in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Nathaniel Coe D.C. #37;
Section 25, Township 3 North, Range 10 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Starting at the T Bar, marked "Initial Point" in the dividing line of Coe Claim, N. 08' E. 40 feet from iron pipe in the ground at the Southeast corner of River-view Park Addition to Hood River, in that portion which is not subdivided into lots and blocks, thence running S. 87° 11' W. 253.4 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe set in the center line of Industrial Street, as per duly recorded plat, at its intersection with Railroad street extended; thence N. 76 degrees 55' W. 65.15 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe in said center line; thence N. 08' E. 200.5 feet more or less to the beginning point of this description in the South line of the right of way of the Oregon Washington Railroad & Navigation Company as established by survey, June 8, 1917; thence following said railroad right of way N. 76 degrees 51' W. 140 feet, more or less; thence S. 08' W. 180 feet, more or less, to the North line of said Industrial Street; thence following said North line of Industrial Street, S. 76 degrees 55' E. 140 feet, more or less; thence N. 08' E. 180 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
