CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT.

This Is to Certify, That KING L. HEISKELL

of Tiller, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17774 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 29, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.024 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ & NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2¹/₂ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
 1.4 acres in NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄
 0.5 acres in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄
 Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

BEGINNING at a point from which the quarter section corner between Sections 27 and 28 of Township 30 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, bears north 38° 03' West 1163.7 feet, thence north 39° 42' East 945 feet to the east boundary of the NW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ of Section 27 of said Township and Range, thence South 879 feet along the East boundary of said NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ to its intersection with the center of the South Umpqua River, thence South 77° 55' West 461 feet down stream along the center of said South Umpqua River, thence North 31° 34' West 291 feet to the place of beginning, EXCEPTING therefrom the County Road right of way crossing the above described premises in northeasterly direction. The net area contained in the above described tract is 6.24 acres more or less, situated in the NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 27 Township 30 South Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, in DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
