**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**    HOWARD HULL

of Bullards Route, Coquille, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Branch of Mill Creek a tributary of Mill Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18008 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 20, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.038 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 8, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.1 of one cubic foot per second ~~per acre~~ or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.038 c.f.s.,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.95 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 8  
Township 28 South, Range 14 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, T. 28 S. R. 14W. W.M. and all that portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5 of the same township lying south of the Seven Devils Road comprising 2.94 acres. Excepting that the following portion of the above is in the names of Howard and Carol Hull and Hugh and Ruth Lennon, to wit: Beginning at a point on the south boundary of the Seven Devils road which is 222 ft. north and 400 ft. southwesterly along south boundary of said road from the NE corner of said section 8; thence South 1039 ft.; West 467 ft.; North 1000 ft. to south boundary Seven Devils Road; thence northeasterly 467 to beginning

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
