## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That J. E. PROWELL and FLORENCE PROWELL

of Baker, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Powder River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 70 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from April 24, 1885;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  $\frac{1}{40}$ th of one cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  .  
40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  .  
10 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  .  
Section 25,  
Township 8 South, Range 40 East, W. M.

Note: This certificate of water right together with certificate of water right recorded at page 19536, volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms changes in place of use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer entered November 10, 1924, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to G. L. Huffman and recorded at page 4238, volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
