CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. E. WHINERY

of Route 2, Box 513, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River
a tributary of for the purpose of

irrigation and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 17842 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 7, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 9 (NE4 NE4), Section 35, Township 35 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{12}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is

appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

A strip of land 100 feet wide, measured in a North and South Direction, across the entire South side of the following described premises, towit:

Beginning at the North quarter corner of Section 35 in Township 35 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon and run thence South along the North and South center line of said Section 35, 300 feet; thence East parallel with the North line of said Section, 2264 feet, more or less to the westerly bank of Rogue River; thence Northerly along the Westerly bank of said River to the North line of Said Section 35; thence West along the North line of said Section, 2252 feet more or less to the visit of the butter for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
