CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. J. HINKS

of Box 178, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Reese Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18179 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10 & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, T. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{8}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 7 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10
8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9
Township 35 South, Range 1 West, T. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

The South half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian; Also, beginning at a point 375 feet North of the Section corner common to Sections 9, 10, 15, and 16 in Township 35 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian; and running thence North 71 degrees East 225 feet; thence North 6 degrees East 108 feet; thence North 53 degrees 30' East 156 feet; thence North 70 degrees East 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet; thence North 50 degrees East 172 feet; thence North 10 degrees East 146 feet; thence North 78 degrees East 95 feet; thence North 68 degrees East 100 feet; thence North 44 degrees East 84 feet; thence North 24 degrees East 136 feet; thence South 63 degrees East 100 feet to the West line of the Crater Lake Highway; thence North 138 feet; thence West 1300 feet; thence South 245 feet to the place of beginning, all in Section 10, Township 35 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
