CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN L. MAHAFFEY

of Wamic, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Pine Hollow a tributary of White River for the purpose of irrigation and supplemental irrigation under Permit No. 17220 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 18, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second ~~per acre~~ and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed one acre foot per acre during any 30-day period up to July 1st of each year and not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; provided, that the rate of flow shall not exceed one-fourtieth of a second-foot per acre up to July 1st of each year and thereafter not to exceed one-eightieth of a second-foot per acre, except in case of rotation, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.50 c.f.s.; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands and shall ~~shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein~~ conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

PRIMARY IRRIGATION

17.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
5.6 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
2.8 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION

1.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
2.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

All in Section 12
Township 4 South, Range 12 East, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
