**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify,** That GEORGE C., EDWIN B. & ETHEL L. MAYFIELD

of Tygh Valley, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mayfield Spring a tributary of White River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17565 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 21, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 16, Township 4 South, Range 13 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from May 23rd to August 20th of each year, 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated after August 20th of each year and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.38 c.f.s.,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
2.1 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
6.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 10, T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Volume 109, page 249, J. E. Baldock and Florence Baldock, husband and wife, to Edwin B. Mayfield and Ethel L. Mayfield, husband and wife, Ja. 24, 1947—  
"The Northeast Quarter of the Northwest quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 15; All that part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10, lying south of the center of the channel of White River; also the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10; the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, all in Township 4 South, Range 13 East of the Willamette Meridian." Volume 109, page 252, J. E. Baldock and Florence Baldock, husband and wife to George C. Mayfield, a single man, January 24, 1947. "All of the East half of the Southeast quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 10; the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 11; the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 14; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 15, all in T. 4 S., R. 13 E. W.M. Also the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 14; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, all in T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W.M."

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
