**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** ORA CARD LANHAM

of Route 1, Box 388, Gold Hill, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs a tributary of Birdseye Creek, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic, including the irrigation of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 18728 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2 gallons per minute, being 1 gpm from each spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , & NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
