CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. L. HATCH

of Aumsville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unramed sloughs

a tributary of North Santiam River

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 12586 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 29, 1937

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE_4^1 NE_4^1 & NE_4^1 SE_4^1), Section 19, Township 9 South, Renge 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.4 acres in Lot 1 (SE2 NE4)
0.4 acres in Lot 1 (NE2 SE4)
0.5 acres in Lot 5 (SW4 NE4)
Section 19, Township 9 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Lot one in Section Nineteen, Township Nine South, Range one West of the Willamette Meridian, containing 37.13 acres of land more or less. Also the following described premises, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of a tract of land deeded to Marth L. Campbell by H. C. Porter and wife, said beginning being the Northwest corner of Lot One in Section Nineteen, Township Nine South, Range One West of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence South along the West line of said Lot One, 24 rods, thence West parallel with the South line of Nathan McNeill's land to the Easterly line of the George Neal Donation Land claim, thence North 25° 15' West along said Easterly line to the Southwest corner of the tract of land formerly owned by Nathan McNeill which is also the Southwest Corner of the J. M. Critchard D.L.C. No. 13 in Township Nine South, Range One, West of the Willamette Meridian, thence East along the South line of said D.L.C. to the place of beginning, containing 6 acres of land more or less. Also beginning at a point on the East boundary line of the D.L.C. of Geo. Neal and Wife, No. 39 in Township Nine South, Range One West of the Willamette Meridian in the center of the county road leading from Marion to Stayton, said point being approximately 110 rods Northerly from the Southeast corner of said D.L.C., and running thence Southerly along the said East boundary line of said claim 89 rods thence Westerly and at right angles to said East boundary line 20 ft., thence Northerly and parallel with said East boundary line of said D.L.C. to the center of said countyroad, thence Easterly along the center of said road to the place of beginning and containing 0.67/100 of an acre.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
