CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST A. WINTERFELD

of Route 1, Box 113 A, Scappoose, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Scappoose Creek a tributary of Scappoose Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18670 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 31, 1949,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Wm. G. Poppleton DLC #38, Section 15, Township 3 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
11.2 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) All projected on Wm. G.
10.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Poppleton D.L.C. #38
2.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 15
Township 3 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

PARCEL I: Commencing at a point 9.94 chains South of the northwest corner of Section 15, Township 3 North of Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Columbia County, Oregon; thence South 20 chains more or less, to the South line of the William G. Poppleton Donation land claim; thence East along said South line of Donation Land claim 24.17 chains; thence North 29.94 chains more or less to Section line between Sections 10 and 15; thence West 16.67 chains to Section line; thence South 9.94 chains; thence West 7.50 chains to the place of beginning, being a portion of the William G. Poppleton Donation Land claim, Columbia County, Oregon.

PARCEL II: Lots 3 and 4 in Section 15, Township 3 North, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, according to the United States Government Plat approved March 5, 1862 by the Surveyor General. Excepting therefrom that part of said Lot 3 described in deed from Andrew Chalick and Beta Chalick to A. G. Chalick and J. G. Chalick, dated July 23, 1921 and recorded August 4, 1921 in book 31, page 536, deed records of Columbia County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
