## This Is to Certify, That JOHN J. KLASSEN

of Route 3, Box 85, Dallas , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Ash Creek

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 15658 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 10, 1913

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA NEA & SEA NEA, as projected on James Harris DLC #44, Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, W. H.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

> as projected on James Harris D.L.C. #44 6.0 acres in SEA NEA, as projected on James Harris D.L.C. #44 Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, WM.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a point 21.64 chains South of the Northeast corner of Section 3 in Township 8 South, Range 5 West of the Millamette Meridian in Polk County, Oregon, thence West 35.04 chains thence South 7.58 chains, to the North line of the Oregonian Railroad Company's right-of-way; thence South 69° East along the North line of said right-of-way 37.60 chains, thence North 20.88 chains to the place of beginning and containing 50.0 acres more or less. Excepting therefrom a road and gateway 30 feet in width off from the West side of said tract.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
