CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That C. A. & H. F. HAWKINS

of Jacksonville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed gulch & Bishop Creek a tributary of Forest Creek, a tributary of Big Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation, mining & domestic under Permit No. 13131 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 21, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.10 cubic feet per second, being 0.045 c.f.s. from Bishop Creek & 0.045 c.f.s. from unnamed gulch for irrigation; 0.01 c.f.s. from Bishop Creek for domestic; & 0.50 c.f.s. from Bishop Creek & 0.50 c.f.s. from unnamed gulch for mining,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Bishop Cr. for dom. & irr. SW4 NW4; unnamed gulch for irr. NW4 SW4; unnamed gulch for mining SW4 NW4 SW4; in Section 30, T. 38 S., R. 2 W., W.M.; Bishop Cr. for mining in NE4 NE4, Section 25, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. M.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed has acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7 acres, domestic & mining in the NW1 SW1 NV1 Section 30, T. 38 S., R. 2 W., W. H.

Mining in the NE4 NE4 Section 25, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W. H.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
