## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. & T. LUMBER COMPANY

of Wilderville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Slate Creek

a tributary of Applegate River

for the purpose of

mill pond

under Permit No. 17653 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 2, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NNL NW2, Section 6, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW1 NW1 Section 6 Township 37 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

All of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 6 in Township 37 South, Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Oregon.

Reserving therefrom such ditch right of way as now exists.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
