CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OTTO BEHNKE

of ~~Free water~~ ^{U-196} ~~the satisfaction~~ of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well tributary of _____ for the purpose of

irrigation under Permit No. _____ of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 21, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.6 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:

Beginning at a Stone 683.5 feet South of the NE Corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 21 Twp. 6N R 35 E.W.M.; thence Northwesterly 1633.2 feet to a stone; thence Southwesterly 319.8 feet to a stone; thence Southeasterly 92.5 feet to a stone; thence Southeasterly 1623.0 feet to a stone on the East line of Said Section 21; thence North along said East line 349.7 feet to point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
